A. Danese Attilio, *L'io dell'altro. Confronto con Paul Ricoeur (Other's I. Comparison with Paul Ricoeur)*, Marietti, Genova 1993

This book presents a comparison between some expert's thoughts and Ricoeur's thoughts, starting from the book *Soi-même comme un autre*. There are different approaches but many convergences on the acknowledgment of philosophical and ethical "engaged" philosophy as that of Paul Ricoeur. The book is divided in five parts, centred respectively on the discovery of him, inter-subjectivity, hermeneutics, the relationship between phenomenology ontology and ethics.

Interviews and encounters conclude the book. Ricoeur's thoughts come back to its Personalist root, in the exploration of "himself" through the tightened passage between Cartesian "cogito" and Nietzsche's destructuration, between Heidegger (and its post metaphysical ontology) and Lévinas (and the positivism of face given as a light of look). In the ethical tripod that delineates person: esteem of oneself, solitude for the other and wishing to live in just institutions, Ricoeur's thoughts remember that ethos does not overlap and does not oppress, but it helps the natural aspiration to a possible happy life.
